SHAKALAND

Guests are awarded the opportunity to visit a traditional healer and observe their practices. ancient sample beer, and see weapons used by Shaka Zulu to forge an empire.

MSUNDUZI MUSEUM

The Voortrekker Msunduzi Museum in Pietermaritzburg was created in 1912 to profile the Voortrekkers of the KZN region. The museum has since become fully representative of the different cultures of the area, while retaining a focus on the history and culture of the Voortrekkers.

HOWICK FALLS

Howick Falls is 95 metres high and is on the Umgeni River, known as 'KwaNogqaza' by people, the Zulu which translates into 'place of the tall one'. The Ampitheatre, one of the main geographical northern features of Drakensberg is regarded as one of the most imposing cliff faces in the world. It forms part of the Royal Natal National Park.
