South Africa has ten UNESCO World Heritage Sites, areas that have been given special international status for their unique qualities. If you are interested in culture and nature or history, then you may well want to plan a visit to at least one of these unique sites: Robben Island, Vredefort Dome, Drakensberg Mountains and the Cradle of Humankind are our suggestions for this edition.

ROBBEN ISLAND

A former leper colony and mental hospital, Robben Island is nowadays famous for having been the prison for anti-apartheid activists, among them former President Mandela. The "struggle university", as it was known, held captive some of the greatest leaders that conducted South Africa to democracy. The visitors can visit the cell where the world's most famous prisoner spent 18 of his 27 years in prison.

MAROPENG

Located 40 minutes away from Johannesburg, the Maropeng Visitor Centre & Sterkfontein Caves are the two prime sites to learn about the appearing of mankind and its evolution, a journey that began 4 billion years ago when the planet started shaping. At the Sterkfontein Caves alone, the remains of more than 500 hominids have uncovered. been lending credence to the theory that the first humanoids lived in Africa.

DRAKENSBERG

The KwaZulu-Natal's 200km-long escarpment, with peaks that exceed 3 000m, the Berg – as it's more commonly known -is a biodiverse wonderland of river valleys, mountain streams. rugged cliffs, hiking trails and stunning scenery that attracts thousands of tourists, mainly during the hotter summer months: December to February.

VREDEFORT DOME

The meteorite collision that formed the Vredefort Dome happened more than two-million years back. At a speed of 20km per second, the asteroid penetrated 17km deep into the Earth and left an impact crater of roughly 300 km. The remaining structure, the "Vredefort Dome", has 70 km.
