

LIST OF DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR A RETIRED PERSON VISA

- The minimum payment to a foreigner contemplated in section 20(1)(a) of the Act shall be, per month, the amount determined from time to time by the Director-General by notice in the in the Gazette.
- The net worth contemplated in section 20(1)(b) of the Act shall be a combination of assets realizing, per month, the amount determined from time to time by the Director General by notice in Gazette.
- Proof that the applicant is able to fulfill the prescribed financial requirement by means of either:
 - A pension with a minimum value of R37 000,00 per month or an irrevocable retirement annuity or retirement account to the equivalent amount **or**
 - A net worth providing an income of at least R37 000,00 per month

- Form DHA 1738

DURATION AND PERIOD OF ISSUANCE

A retired person work visa shall be issued for a period not exceeding four years.

Important notes:

Incomplete applications are not accepted.

All application forms must be fully filled in with a black ink pen, and legible handwriting.

All details provided by the applicant should be in accordance with the documents produced (e.g. name and surname in accordance with passport details).

Applicants must apply for the visas in person at the South African Embassy in Lisbon, and sign the application forms in the presence of an Embassy Official.

All documents in a foreign language must be translated to English.

A Photo booth is available at the Embassy for international standard photographs. (4xphotos=5euros)

All documents and letters or work contracts must be signed and stamped
