
South Africa has eight UNESCO World Heritage Sites, areas that have been given special international status for their unique qualities. If you are interested in culture and nature or history, then you may well want to plan a visit to at least one of these unique sites: Robben Island, Vredefort Dome, Drakensberg Mountains and the Cradle of Humankind are our suggestions for this edition.

Cradle of Humankind, Johannesburg 40 minutes away from Located Johannesburg, the Cradle of Humankind World Heritage Site is one of Gauteng province's attractions. The Maropeng Visitor Centre & Sterkfontien Caves are the two prime sites to learn about the appearing of mankind and its evolution, a journey that began 4 billion years ago when the planet started shaping. Only at the Sterkfontein Caves alone, the remains of more than 500 hominids have been uncovered, lending credence to the theory that the first humanoids lived in Africa.

Robben Island, Western Cape

A former leper colony, mental hospital and a base for military training, Robben Island World Heritage Site is nowadays famous for having been the prison for anti-apartheid activists. among them former President Nelson Rolihlahla Mandela. The "struggle university", as it was known, held captive some of the greatest leaders that conducted South Africa to democracy. It is South Africa's Statue of Liberty. The visitors may witness the suffering undergone by all those that were forced to be there and see the cell where the world's most famous prisoner spent 18 of his 27 years in prison.



uKhahlamba-Drakensberg, KwaZulu-Natal

South Africa features many mountain ranges, none more impressive than KwaZulu-Natal's 200km-long escarpment. With peaks that exceed 3 000m, the Berg – as it's more commonly known – forms the backbone of the Maloti-Drakensberg Transfrontier Conservation and Development Area between the Kingdom of Lesotho and South Africa. It is a biodiverse wonderland of river valleys, mountain streams, rugged cliffs, hiking trails and stunning scenery that attracts thousands of tourists, mainly during the hotter summer months: December to February.

Vredefort Dome, Free State

Imagine an asteroid the size of Table Mountain heading for earth at a speed of 20km per second. Packing more punch than multiple nuclear bombs, it penetrates 17km deep into the Earth and leaves an impact crater so large it's been declared a World Heritage Site. Thankfully the meteorite collision that formed the Vredefort Dome happened more than two-million years back. The original crater was estimated to have a diameter of roughly 300 km. The remaining structure, the "Vredefort Dome", has 70 km.
